## No denying the Concrete Imaginary

Playing with notions of concretizing the imaginary of the picture plane

Just as the actor believes in the character, an artist must hold to the illusion. How you do that when you have to write explanatory notes is completely beyond me. But who am I to say never?

Of course, 'Concrete Imaginary' is an oxymoron – there are physical means, such as canvas, paint and tape (and concrete), and there is the evocation their particular arrangements produce in the imagination. The imaginary can only be mental.

It's also a bit redundant to "concretize" pictorial space, since it is embedded already in the finite material surface of the painting (or the sculpture, or whatever). And what does it look like, anyway? Surely the Imaginary on its own is too nebulous.

But this is all according to the world of realities. In the world of illusions you do whatever you can get away with. In the movies you can have real mermaid princesses, real aliens and real fictional John Malkoviches. You can even point straight at the deceit, state what you are doing, and the illusion will still hold. Art is good like that.

So when the idea of a Concrete Imaginary popped into my head, I thought, why not give it a go? It's only impossible.
